## What to know: Observe & Report

### #1 KEEP CALM & REPORT

- **BRIEFLY** describe incident
- **LOCATION** of incident
- **DESCRIPTION** for  
**Victim(s) / Suspect(s)**
  - Male/Female
  - Race
  - Age Range
  - Build / Height / Weight
  - Clothing (hair, hat)
- **Mode of TRANSPORTATION**
  - Make / Model  
(bike, skateboard, etc.)
  - Color
  - Number of doors
  - License plate (as much as  
possible)
  - Direction traveling
  - Distinguishing traits  
(spoiler, stickers, dents, etc.)
- **Number of PEOPLE INVOLVED**
- **Do you RECOGNIZE anyone?**
- **WHEN** did it happen?
- **Was anything USED AS  
A WEAPON?**
- **Is it a PERSON, PROPERTY  
OR VEHICLE crime?**
